### Technical Standards for Health Science Programs at Washtenaw Community College (WCC)

The technical standards aim to inform students choosing to enter a Health Sciences Certificate and Degree Program at WCC with the bare minimal technical standard requirements, which must be met to complete all coursework objectives and student outcomes. The listed standards encompass what is minimally required to perform the tasks necessary, with a few associated examples provided. This list is not exhaustive and can be modified as the College deems necessary. Students enrolled in a Health Science program at WCC must provide safe and effective care. These technical standards apply to any student enrolling in any one of the health sciences programs. To meet program technical standards, the student must demonstrate sufficient cognitive, emotional, professional, motor (physical), sensory, and other abilities, with or without accommodation.

**Critical Thinking, Emotional, and Cognitive Competencies**
 Sufficient critical thinking and cognitive abilities in classroom and clinical settings

**Professionalism**
 Interpersonal skills sufficient for professional interaction with a diverse population of individuals, families, and groups

**Communication**
 Communication sufficient for professional interactions

**Mobility**
 Physical abilities sufficient for movement from room to room and in small spaces

**Motor Skills**
 Gross and fine motor abilities that are sufficiently effective and safe for providing Allied Health Care

**Sensory**
 Auditory and visual ability sufficient for observing, monitoring, and assessing health needs

**Observation**
 Ability to sufficiently make observations in a healthcare environment, consistent with program competencies

**Tactile Sense**
 Tactile ability sufficient for physical assessment
