When the decision was made to deactivate these programs, construction projects were dwindling and there wasn't a high demand for skilled construction laborers. Today's reality is very different and there will be individuals going into the industry looking for ways to stand out among their peers. For this reason, we are creating the new Construction Technology AAS degree, and as part of this effort, bringing back CTCON1 and CVCON2 to be embedded into this new degree, providing students with the opportunity to earn stackable credentials as they work through the program. Both of these certificates had started the phase out process, but we now find renewed justification in the newly revived construction industry. The four courses that were inactivated, but part of CVCON2, are being reactivated as well. We're confident that these were simply ahead of their time, and that this new landscape means the program can have a strong and lasting positive impact for our students.  CON 220 has been inactivated and replaced by CMG 225. The new Construction Technology AAS degree will include CVCON2 as a nested certificate.
