

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**  
between  
**Washtenaw Community College**  
Radiography Associate in Applied Science  
and  
**Monroe County Community College**

**Article I - Agreement on Principle**

This articulation agreement between Washtenaw Community College (WCC) and Monroe County Community College (MCCC) will go into effect September 1, 2018.

**Whereas**, both colleges desire to make available a radiography program to their students, *and*

**Whereas**, both colleges are state licensed and HLC approved community colleges, *and*

**Whereas**, WCC does provide a Radiography program accredited by the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology, *and*

**Whereas**, both colleges desire to provide educational services to their students, *and*

**Whereas**, both colleges recognize the community and professional need for Radiographers

These two institutions agree that students, who want to earn an associate's degree in Radiography, should be provided with a smooth curriculum transition that minimizes loss of credit and duplication of coursework. Therefore, WCC and MCCC agree to develop a curriculum articulation agreement for students who complete the designated prerequisite courses and transfer to WCC to complete the Associate in Applied Science in Radiography. Both parties enter into this agreement as cooperating, equal partners, who shall maintain the integrity of their separate programs.

**Article II**  
**Agreement on Program Specifics**

WCC and MCCC agree that students who successfully complete the prerequisites courses outlined on the attached articulation guide may apply to transfer the course credits indicated toward an AAS in Radiography. Students who follow this articulated program agreement must apply and be admitted to WCC and to the Radiography program.

**MCCC will:**

1. Screen interested applicants in their service area through their admissions office.
2. Refer qualified candidates to WCC for final selection and program orientation.
3. Provide the academic courses listed below:

2. Accept the number of MCCC students that the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology recommends for ProMedica Monroe Regional Hospital Clinical Education Center or other clinical education centers in MCCC's service area that are affiliated with WCC, not to exceed ten (10) students.
3. Accept all satisfactorily earned (2.00 GPA or equivalent or higher where indicated above) credits taken at MCCC.
4. Award the Associate in Applied Science degree to all MCCC students who complete the requirements for the degree.

5. Provide over-all supervision by the Program Director and Dean of Health Sciences.
6. Provide clinical supervision.
7. Maintain a JRCERT approved Radiography program.

### **Article III**

#### **Agreement on Communication**

WCC and MCCC agree to cooperate in communicating with each other, and with their common and respective publics, concerning the established relationship between the two institutions. Communication may include the development of various kinds of publications to inform those who might benefit personally or professionally from the opportunities provided by this agreement. Faculty and staff at both institutions will share the information in this agreement with interested and qualified students, and both institutions will provide counseling and advising to students and prospective students.

### **Article IV**

#### **Maintenance and Review Procedures**

At least one administrative or faculty member from each institution will be appointed to act as agents for the implementation of this agreement, to speak for the institutions and to communicate changes to respective faculty members, advisors, counselors, and others to whom the information is pertinent. Responsibility for oversight of this agreement rests with the Program Director of Radiography at WCC and the Dean of Health Sciences at MCCC. Both parties agree to communicate annually any changes in their respective programs that may affect this articulation agreement.

#### **Termination**

Either party may terminate this agreement at any time by notice given to the other party in writing prior to the effective date of the termination. Whenever possible, WCC and MCCC will facilitate the successful completion of the program for students who have been admitted prior to program termination

**Effective Date: September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2021.**

This agreement is consistent with the 2018-2019 catalog.

We, the representatives of **Washtenaw Community College** and **Monroe County Community College**, agree to the terms of this agreement, which will be for an initial **period** of three (3) years.
